- At the end of each play season or when temperature falls below 32°F / 0°C, outdoor use of this product is not recommended. In extreme cold, plastic materials lose resilience and may become brittle and crack upon impact. Remove and store product indoors.
- Discard all packaging properly after the unit has been assembled.
- Disassemble and dispose of this product in a safe place and manner, so as not to present any safety hazards to other individuals who may come upon the discarded item.
